

## Directions to St. Thomas Seminary

### From North (Enfield, Windsor Locks)

91 South to Exit 35B to Rt. 218. Turn right onto Rt. 218. Continue West for 4 miles to Rt. 189 (Bloomfield Ave.) and turn left onto Rt. 189 South. Seminary is ½-mile down on the right.

### From South

91 North to Exit 35B, Rt. 218. Turn left onto Rt. 218. Continue West for 4 miles to Rt. 189 (Bloomfield Ave.) and turn left onto Rt. 189 South. Seminary is ½-mile on right.

### From East (Manchester, East Hartford)

Take Bissell Bridge, Rt. 291 to Exit 1 (Rt. 218, Bloomfield Ave.). Turn left at the end onto Rt. 189 (Bloomfield Ave.) and turn left onto Rt. 189 South. Seminary is ½-mile on right.

### From West (Waterbury, Bristol, New Britain)

East on Rt. 84 to Prospect Ave., Exit 44. Turn left and proceed 2½ miles to end of Prospect. Turn right onto Rt. 44 (Albany Ave.) and immediately at next light turn left onto Rt. 189 North (Bloomfield Ave.). Seminary is 1½ miles on left.


